Type 1 and 2 plastics are accepted. Please clean and separate. No lids.

Type 1	
Translucent/clear	
water, soda, juice bottles	
Type 2	
White/opaque	
milk jugs, laundry detergent	

Don't forget to scoop the poop and clean up after your furry friends. Bag locations are on Main Street:



- Attached to parking sign near Wells Fargo
- Attached to the light pole in front of the Coho
- Also available at Copper River Watershed Project and the Native Village of Eyak

## Gillnet and seine web recycling program underway



Recycle unwanted gillnet, seine web and leadline for free at four locations in Cordova:

- Redden Marine
- The Harbormaster
- Alaska Fisherman's Camp
- The City Baler

- **NO LINES** in the web container. It causes the entire bin to be discarded
- **Clean web only, please remove any non-nylon materials.**

Leadline and corkline can also be recycled in designated locations near web containers .

Used web will be shipped to Seattle, baled, shipped over-seas to be recycled into items such as auto parts, bike seats, carpets and more.

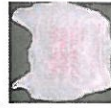
