



# HOW TO RECYCLE YOUR GILLNET OR SEINE WEB

It's as simple as 1, 2, 3!



**1. Cut.**

**2. Bundle.**

**3. Deposit.**

It's free, and it keeps web from damaging our city's trash baler!

## NET RECYCLING GUIDES:

### 1. CUT - CLEAN WEB AND ONLY WEB.

Remove any non-nylon materials; **no cork, lead or weedlines allowed.** Web can be stripped or cut away from the lines. Rinse with fresh water to remove debris.

### 2. BUNDLE - MAKE IT EASY TO MOVE/YARD.

Web can be bundled and tied with hanging twine, wrapped in a piece of patch web or rolled in a tight bundle. **Please do not bag.**

### 3. DEPOSIT - PUT IN MARKED CONTAINERS.

Deposit bundled web to the **back** of the container. Cordova Recycling Network marked containers are located at the following collection sites:

**City Refuse Dept. (Baler at 1mi. Whiteshed Rd.) & Redden Marine (Behind Harbormaster's Office).**
