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Building Permit Certificate

Authorized Activities

Replace two existing undersized culverts with larger stream simulation culverts at two locations within the Sheridan Glacier River Floodplain on the Copper River Delta near Cordova.

All work must be in accordance with work plans submitted by Lessee and approved by ADOT&PF, and in accordance with any requirements of FAA and Fire Marshal.

No construction or demolition other than that specifically stated above is authorized by this Permit. For construction changes or additions, contact the State of Alaska, Department of Transportation and Public Facilities. It is the responsibility of the Tenant/Contractor to determine and obtain all required permits, certificates and approvals prior to commencement of any work.

These activities must comply with all provisions provided in the enclosed addendum and letter.

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## BUILDING PERMIT ADDENDUM

All demolition and/or construction must be performed in compliance with applicable portions of the TSA-approved Airport Safety Program and the FAA-approved Airport Certification Manual.
